Each match will consist of 2 or 3 games. If the same player is the winner of the first two games, the 3rd game will not be played. In each match the highest seeded player is deciding whether he wants to begin the first game on the left or right lane. In the second game the order of players will be opposite to the first game and in a possible third game, the order of players will be the same as in the first game.

Practise will take place at the assigned pair of lanes for a match.

After 5 minutes of practise, the highest ranked player must take his/her decision, where after the practise can continue yet some minutes until the score system is announced ready and the matches is announced to begin.

In case of a tie in a game, a one ball roll off on a full set of pins will be played, repeated until the tie is broken. The players will, for the first roll off delivery, be positioned on the lanes where they ended the game. The highest ranked player after the qualification will chose the order of play. For a second roll off delivery the players will switch lanes and the order of deliveries will be opposite to the first one and so on.
